Aladdin JR Synopsis

The story you know and love has been given the royal treatment! Show Dates

Ensemble members will be split into two separate casts, performing in 5 shows each. Pit singers will also be selected to perform in all shows. Understudies will have their own performance on Friday 11 October. How roles will be split will be determined following auditions.

Rehearsal Dates

Cast are expected to be available for all rehearsals. Please let the production team know of any unavailabilities prior to, or at auditions. Cast must be available for all tech week rehearsals and performances.

Financial Commitment

Cast members will need to become a Fantasia Showstoppers member if successful. Membership is \$30 and your membership will be valid until the end of 2024. Membership is \$20 for each subsequent sibling, and each membership comes with an Adult Associate membership. Membership fees will be due by 20 July 2023.

There will be a show fee of \$350 for all performers. Your show fee will include a cast shirt to keep, a script, as well a copy of the filmed performance. The show fee will also go towards our production costs and rehearsal materials.

Financial relief is available for a limited number of cast members. Up to 50% of Show Fees may be waived in the case of financial hardship. To apply for relief, please email Treasurer@FantasiaShowstoppers.com.au, outlining your situation.

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders are also entitled to apply for a Show Fee exemption and can apply for the Indigenous Scholarship as outlined on the Audition Request form.

Applications for Show Fee relief and exemption will be considered at the next monthly Committee Meeting and results will be emailed to applicants directly after the meeting.

Other Awards and Grants may also be available (to a maximum of \$3000) to assist members with furthering their musical knowledge, training or experience. Applications will be considered on a case by case basis where funds are available.

Fundraising

Fundraising is a pivotal component of mounting our productions and we need a commitment from cast and parents to assist with this. We host a trivia event that all cast are required to attend with a parent or designated supervisor. We also hold BBQ fundraisers at Bunnings. There are 5 people required per 2 hour blocks at each BBQ. We ask that cast families either attend a shift or provide donations including drinks, food and condiments.

Role	Age	Vocal Range	Description
Aladdin (Male) Principle	12-18	G2 - E4	Charismatic, poor street urchin; longs to make his mother proud. Competent movement skills preferred.
Jasmine (Female) Principle	12-18	G3 - E5	Princess of Agrabah; craves the freedom to make her own choices. Competent movement skills preferred.
Genie (Any) Principle	12-18	G2 - D#4	All-powerful, fast-talking wisecracker and prisoner of the lamp. Competent movement skills preferred.
Jafar (Any) Principle	12-18	Bb2 - Eb4	The Sultan's villainous Grand Vizier.
Saltan (Any) Principle	12-18	Ab3 - C4	Warmhearted ruler of Agrabah. This role only has one small solo singing part.
Iago (Any) Featured	8-18	Bb2 - E4	Jafar's lackey; always over-eager to assist in an evil plan.
Babkak (Any) Featured	8-18	G2 - E4	Aladdin's devoted and penniless pal.
Omar (Any) Featured	8-18	G2 - E4	Aladdin's devoted and penniless pal.

Kassim (Any) Featured	8-18	G2 - E4	Aladdin's devoted and penniless pal.
Isir (Any) Featured	8-18	B3 - Eb5	Jasmine's loyal, encouraging attendant. Strong harmony singer preferred.
Manal (Any) Featured	8-18	B3 - Eb5	Jasmine's loyal, encouraging attendant. Strong harmony singer preferred.
Rajah (Any) Featured	8-18	B3 - Eb5	Jasmine's loyal, encouraging attendant. Strong harmony singer preferred.
Razoul (Any) Featured	8-18	D3-E3	Head of the Guards.
Prince Abdullah (Any) Featured	8-18	NA	One of Princess Jasmine's arrogant suitors. This role does not have any featured solo singing pieces.
Ensemble	8-18	Any	The ensemble plays Agrabahns which includes various featured solo spoken and singing roles, Genie's ensemble in 'Friend Like Me', as well as Prince Ali's Entourage.

Accents are not required. Any gender will be considered for roles. You may present the characters how you see them. If you are auditioning for multiple roles you will be asked to present for the role that you are most interested in.





Junior Theatre Festival Australia

This is a perk of our second season program and all cast members are encouraged to attend. There are opportunities for:

Pilot Program (21 - 25 October 2024)

Five of the best performers from each company are selected to spend a week of intensive working on a new musical, which is performed to the rest of the festival attendees on the weekend.

The Festival (25 - 26 October 2024)

A two day celebration of theatre where our cast performs a 15 minute excerpt of our *Aladdin JR* production and receives feedback from industry professionals, as well as attends workshops for singing, dancing and acting.

All Stars Auditions

This is an opportunity for the best performers from each company to audition to attend an intensive training program in America, where they attend workshops on Broadway, the international Junior Theatre Festival in Atlanta, and the Imagination Campus at Disneyland California.

JOINING US

Why choose Fantasia Showstoppers?

Fantasia Showstoppers was founded in 2020 to provide meaningful and accessible creative opportunities for young people aged 8-18 in Sydney's West.

If your child seeks the thrill of a creative adventure, or you are searching to unlock their super-charged social confidence, your child will feel right at home with Fantasia Showstoppers.

Our programs centre around offering weekly workshops to develop skills in theatre and performance, while empowering young people in the West to be confident and creative and to connect with their community.

AUDITIONS

I don't have any experience with singing, dancing or acting, can I still be in the show? Everyone is welcome to audition regardless of their experience. Some people will have years of experience and others will never have performed before. If your audition is successful, this is a great time to learn new skills and experience the magic of theatre.

My child has activities during one or two of the days and times listed, does this mean that they cannot participate?

Of course your child can still participate! At the time of auditions, you will need to advise us of any conflicts.

MEMBERSHIP AND SHOW FEES

I am having trouble paying the fees. Are there options for assistance?

Financial relief is available for a limited number of cast members. Up to 50% of fees may be waived. Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders are also entitled to apply for show fee exemption and can apply for the Indigenous Scholarship as mentioned on the Audition Request form.

REHEARSALS

When is the first Rehearsal and where?

Richmond School of Arts on 21 July, 11am to 5pm

Do Parents attend the first Rehearsal?

Yes. We will have an orientation where all cast and a parent/carer needs to attend. We will be discussing the information pack with all further information that you will need for our production. This should roughly take no more than an hour. Please aim to arrive 10 minutes prior to 11am so we can start on time.

What should my child wear for first rehearsal?

We will be doing cast and crew photos at our first rehearsal so please ensure they are wearing a black t-shirt or shirt, with no logos or stripes. Cast members may like to do their hair and makeup for this occasion too.

Are all performers called to every rehearsal?

No. We do our best to keep a comprehensive rehearsal schedule with names of the cast that is required each rehearsal and that is kept on our Production Team Facebook page pinned to the top in the 'Featured' Section and will be updated often. You are encouraged to look at this schedule on Facebook regularly prior to any rehearsal in case your date/time has changed or additional rehearsals are needed (at the discretion of the production team).

Are there any mandatory dates?

Yes! The final week of rehearsals, Tech Week and ALL shows are mandatory. 23 September up to and including 12 October.

If my child can't make a rehearsal or is running late, who do I contact?

You will need to get in touch with our Production Manager - David Catterall

Can my child/children practice at home?

Absolutely! There will be a folder accessible to parents and performers where recordings from rehearsals will be uploaded to assist with learning vocal parts at home. Please review these with your kids. They should be writing down what part they need to learn however there will be a concise sheet for them. Not everyone is in every song so this will be made clear on their individual sheets.

PERFORMANCE WEEK

Do I need to provide anything for my child/children for the production? You will receive access to the document **Rehearsals to Stage** which will cover all information including makeup, hair, shoes, clothing, costumes, etc.
